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Please Note

1. The Club and its coaches are only responsible for the supervision of the children between designated match/training times. All parents/carers should collect their child(ren) from the pitch at the end of each period or have made appropriate arrangements, of which the coach should be made aware.
2. Please note that the Club is not a crèche and parents/carers must assume that members of the public have access to the grounds and clubhouse (including for away matches or if inclement weather forces us to use a non usual area).
3. All parents/carers are requested to take their own child(ren) to away fixtures; where this is not possible, arrangements should be made with another parent/carer. Coaches already have enough to do!
4. Please arrive for home training / fixtures (as arranged by your Coach) at 10:45 to register with your Coach and to be ready to start training at 11:00. The session ends at 12:30pm. Away matches normally follow the same timetable, unless your Coach advises you differently.
5. The club provides a very good website and encourages players and parents to refer to it for information, especially on fixtures.

Parental/Carer Consent

1. I give permission for the above named child to train and to play rugby in both friendly and competitive games within the Club and against other clubs (which may be home or away). I understand that training or matches may take place at the Coombe Dingle or Stoke Lodge or Portway grounds, or at the grounds of other clubs, or (in inclement weather) at another venue such as on the Bristol Downs.
2. I understand that the Club encourages all parents/carers of all players to remain at the club to support their child(ren) and I undertake to do so. However, in circumstances where I am unable to remain then I will arrange suitable "cover" by another parent/carer and I will inform the player's Coach of the arrangement.
3. I confirm that I have declared all relevant medical details and any condition which may affect the above player during a session. If the above named player requires medicine then I confirm that he/she is able to self-administer, or that I have made/will make specific arrangements to be present or to ensure that an appropriate person to assist is present at all times. I undertake to notify the player's Coach of this information at each session.
4. I give permission for the above named child to have his/her photograph taken in team photographs or "action" photographs. I understand that these photographs may appear on the club website and/or in Club literature or promotions / advertising, but that no child's name, or other identification, will be used in conjunction with the photograph. I give permission for the above named child to be video recorded playing or training and I understand that this will be strictly for coaching purposes.
5. In the event of an injury, I give permission for the above named child to be 'first aid' treated by an appropriate person, and for emergency removal to hospital should the need arise. In such circumstances, I understand that the Club will attempt to contact me or, failing, that, the designated emergency contact.
6. I confirm that the above named child is up to date with his/her tetanus injections.
7. I confirm that I am legally responsible for the above named child and am entitled to sign this form.
8. I confirm that, in the event that the above named child is a Ward of Court or similar, then I will notify the Club, in writing, of any restrictions of which the Club may need to be aware (e.g. child pick-up arrangements).
9. I understand that the RFU provides limited insurance cover in the event of an accident and that it is my decision whether I will make further arrangements for fuller insurance or other cover.
10. I have read and understood the SBOB Child Protection Policy. I note that a copy is available for me to collect.
11. I have read and understood the SBOB Health & Safety Guide. I note that a copy is available for me to collect. I confirm that the player, and I on the player's behalf, accept full responsibility for wearing appropriate gumshield and safe boots and that he/she is appropriately and safely dressed for all training and matches.
